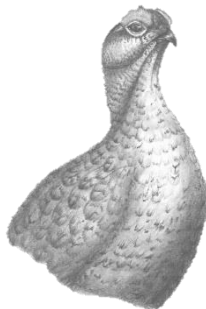

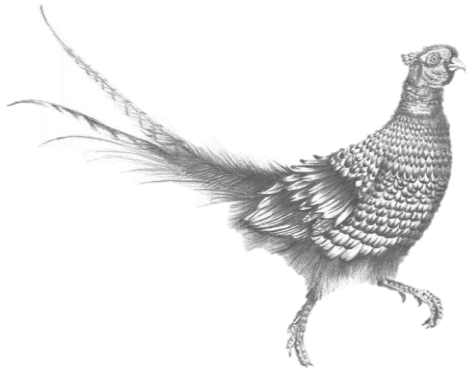

Amori Prosecco, Spumante Extra Dry, Italy

Delightfully crisp and elegant, it has lots of mouth-filling pear, apple and peach flavours which are balanced by a wonderful refreshing acidity. Youthful and vibrant nose. The perfect aperitif from Northeast Italy.

English Sparkling

Chilcomb Valley Classic Cuveé Brut, Hampshire

Golden in colour with an abundance of fine bubbles, the wine has vibrant baked apple, creamy nougat and a little brioche on the nose. With notes of soft lemon sherbet on the palate, and more green apples the wine has endless bright acidity, the signature characteristic of English sparkling wines.

A Blend 80% Pinot Meunier and 20% Chardonnay. It has aromas of ripe fruit and brioche. The bubbles and acidity are marked and perfectly balanced by the vinosity of the wine. A traditional brut champagne, fruity, round and harmonious.

This refreshing Italian classic offers soft summer berries and a hint of tropical fruit on the nose with citrus notes joining on the palate and finish.

La Croix du Prieur Rosé, Côtes de Provence, France, 2023 £12.50 £32

A bright pale pink colour, enveloping an expressive nose of orange pulp and apricot, a prelude to a well-balanced palate, with a zesty finish.

A rich honeyed apricot and raisin flavours with a long lingering finish. One of the wine world's most iconic creations and Ami's favourite.

A note about 'Not a Whisky' ~ Oxford Rye, The Oxford Artisan Distillery

Oxford Rye: not a whisky, not intended to be a whisky, but certainly a preview of the great whiskies to come.

This 'liquid rye', is the purest expression of ancient heritage rye, the grain is harvested, twice distilled and then rested in American Oak to bring out its best characteristics. It has an intoxicating aroma of sandalwood and vanilla, whilst on the palate the delicate flavour of creamy praline, nuts and sourdough is followed by a finish of cloves, nutmeg and smooth spice.

A Little Story about Our Clarified Milk Punch

The earliest recorded recipe for milk punch dates to a 1711 cookbook - making it one of the oldest cocktail recipes known. The punch reached the height of its popularity in the middle of the 18th century when Nathaniel Whisson bottled the beverage which Queen Victoria issued a royal warrant for in 1838 as "purveyors of milk punch to Her Majesty". As the name implies, this is a punch that is made with milk yet is paradoxically perfectly clear.

Our version of this delicious & historical cocktail is made with Sipsmith Gin and flavoured with Tregothnon Earl Grey Tea, Pink Peppercorns, Orange peel & Thyme - to name just a few ingredients and takes 5 days to make.
